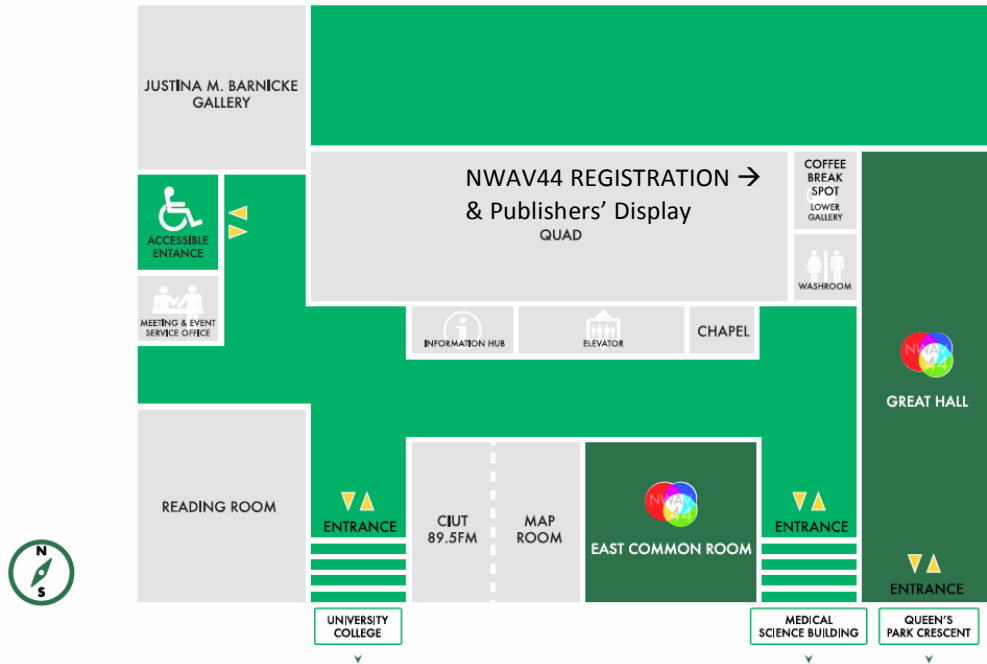
# Hart House Floor Plan

### **A. Royal Ontario Museum (ROM)**

For those interested in the history of POMPEII ancient city, visit the Royal Ontario Museum located on Bloor St. & University Ave. Fee: \$28/ Student: \$25.50.

### **B. Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO)**

For a special art gallery experience, visit AGO located on McCaul St. & Dundas St W. for \$19.50/ Student: \$11

### **C. Casa Loma**

Visit Canada's Majestic Castle, Casa Loma, and step back in time to a period of European elegance and splendour. Address: 1 Austin Terrace, Toronto. General Admission: \$24.

### **D. CN Tower**

A signature icon of Toronto's skyline, and a symbol of Canada. Offers you a unique 360° perspective looking down over Toronto, Lake Ontario and beyond. Address: 301 Front Street West, Toronto. Adult Fee: \$35.

### **E. Yonge-Dundas Square**

A unique focal point of downtown Toronto. Located beside The Eaton Centre, Toronto's biggest shopping centre.

### **F. Distillery District**

The Distillery District is the place to see and be seen. The Distillery features more than 70 ground-floor cultural and retail establishments in the restored red brick, Victorian-era buildings of the renowned Gooderham & Worts whiskey distillery. Free Admission.

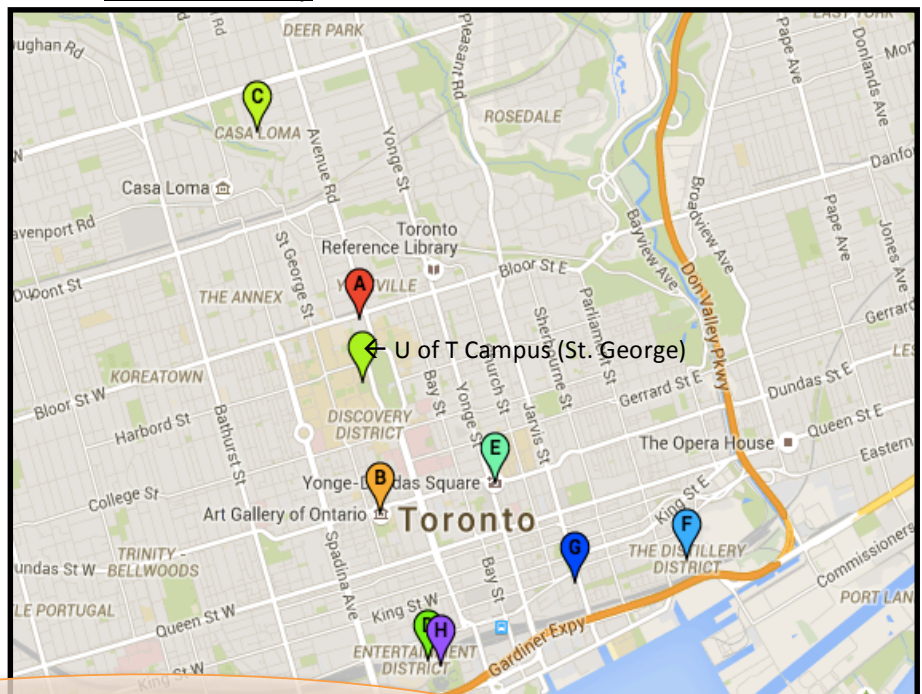
### **G. St. Lawrence Market**

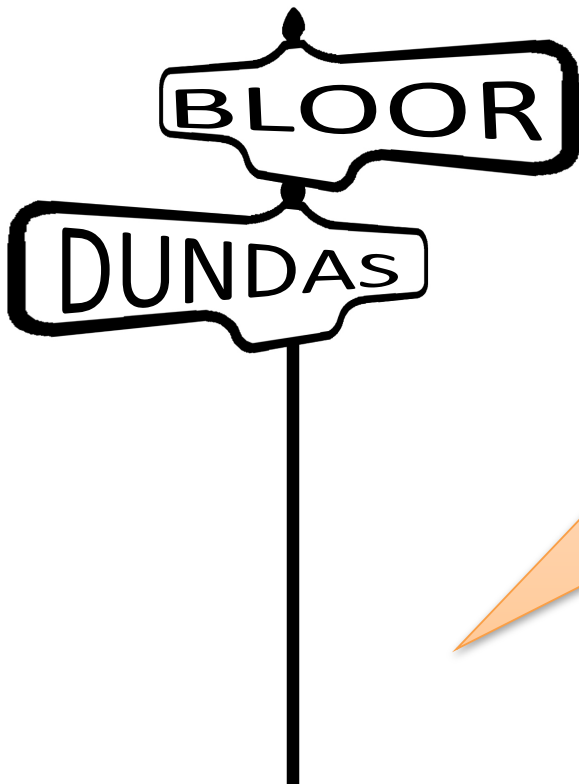

**TAXI:** Beck Taxi Tel: 416-751-5555; Crown Taxi Tel: 416-240-0000.

**TRANSIT:** The Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) is a public transport agency that operates subway, bus, streetcar, paratransit, and rapid transit services in Toronto. The closest TTC station from Hart House is Museum Station located on University Ave. and Bloor St. W. Fare: \$3. Trains run every 3 to 6 minutes from about 6 AM to about 1:20 AM, except on Sundays when they start around 9 AM. See [ttc.ca](http://ttc.ca), TTC mobile application: "TTC Watch for Toronto" for Apple and "Transit Now Toronto for TTC" for Android.

Paying TTC fares: Crossing the turnstile in a subway station requires \$3 in exact change or a token; tokens can be purchased at the window or from a machine where available. Boarding a bus or a streetcar on the street also costs \$3 in exact change or one token. Transferring from one mode of transportation to another within a subway station can be done freely, but doing so out on the street requires a paper transfer pass (picked up where you paid your fare). Day-passes on the TTC system are available for \$11.50 each; if a person is making more than three trips on the TTC within a day, buying a day-pass is the cheapest option.
