Thank you for your message and sorry to keep you waiting. Attached is the information you requested regarding pricing and the venue for NWAV 44.

I'm attaching 2 files: (1) a slideshow that introduces our beautiful venue, Hart House, and (2) a letter with information about our plans for the conference and the various possibilities for publisher participation, including pricing for exhibits and advertisement. We also invite publishers to sponsor special events, such as receptions, which could be used to draw extra attention to important new books. For example, I understand that the edited volume "Language, sexuality and power" is nearing publication with OUP, and I wonder if you would be interested in showcasing it at NWAV, as both Erez Levon and Ronald Mendes are regular NWAV participants.

For my own book, I think that NWAV is the ideal venue to reach an audience of sociolinguists who are interested in issues of language diversity, discrimination, and the rights of linguistic minorities in the United States, but who don't normally follow publications in the field of Language and Law.
